Call for Full papers: deadline Monday 30 January Friday 13 February 2023

Full papers will be thoroughly reviewed by at least three members of the international program committee. High-quality submissions will be accepted for presentation at the conference and published in LIPIcs, the Leibniz International Proceedings in Informatics series. Manuscripts must describe original work that has neither been published before, nor is currently under review elsewhere. Papers must be written in English and should not exceed fifteen pages (including title, figures, and references) and in the required layout. Call for Short papers: deadline Monday 8 May 2023

Short papers that report on work in progress will be reviewed by at least three members of the international program committee. Accepted papers in this track will be selected for oral presentation and published in the LIPIcs conference proceedings. Short papers must be written in English and should not exceed six pages (including title, figures, and references) and in the requested LIPIcs layout. In addition, each submission must have a subtitle 'Short Paper' to distinguish Full papers from Short papers. Details are at https://giscience2023.github.io/pages/calls paper.html.
